An Advent Reading Calendar

I've seen many different kinds of Advent Calendars over the years. Some are just cardboard with 24 doors to open – one for each day of December up to Christmas Eve – and behind each door is some kind of cute picture.

Now they have some with boxes inset into the cardboard with a small toy behind each door. If they are building blocks, they end up providing enough pieces to create a complete winter scene of some kind. Some may even have small nativity pieces to help us remember the "Reason for the Season."

However, my favorite idea is not a calendar at all, but to build memories by reading one chapter of the Gospel of Luke each night for the 24 days of December through Christmas Eve.

Not only is it a wonderful thing that the numbers happen to line up so perfectly – it also helps to line up our thinking with the **true** "Heart of Christmas."

If you have family or neighbors with which to share this practice as an expression of Christian discipleship, then so much the better. Children will gain a greater

understanding of the Gospel, and adults who may already know the story will find it reinforced in their thoughts and hearts. What a great gift to share, when so much in life distracts us from the Heart of Christmas: the overwhelming gift of God when He came to earth, made one with humanity in Jesus Christ, and ultimately died on the Cross for us so we could live with Him forever.

Get your favorite reading Bible and place a bookmark at Luke chapter 1. Practice good study habits and prepare for an amazing blessing.




