

My Last Page

As Joshua prepared to take leave of the people, he had the right thing to say, so I am going to borrow from him: Now I am about to go the way of all the earth. You know with all your heart and soul that not one of all the good promises the LORD your God gave you has failed. Every promise has been fulfilled; not one has failed. (Joshua 23:14)

Of course, I am NOT about to die (so far as I know) – but the essential element of absence is similar.

Joshua was getting ready to leave, but what was on his heart was nothing about himself – but about God's plans, God's provision, God's faithfulness – and God's glory.

Notice how the common principle in facing every change is: The Unchanging.

Life – in an imperfect world – is in constant turmoil – tossed by the waves of change, covered by the shifting sands of time.

Change is integral to this changing world, (1 Corinthians 7:31), but God is the One who connects the past and the future with unchanging grace (James 1:17, Lamentations 3:22).

In our situation, like Joshua and Israel's, there was a change in leadership – but because God was still God, the continuity of <u>God's</u> leadership continued, just as it had when Moses had "retired" and Joshua had been appointed to take up the role of God's point-guard.

This is the most important aspect for every one of us, whether we are leaving, staying, coming, or just scratching our heads with a mild sense of bewilderment as to what comes next. Life isn't about us – not about you, not about me – it's about

Jesus, because Jesus IS Life. (See John 11:25, 14:6, 17:3, and First John 1:2, 5:20.)

We can rest, assured that "Not one of all the good promises the LORD your God gave you has failed. Every promise has been fulfilled; not one has failed." Nor will they ever fail (read all of **Isaiah chapter 55**, focusing on verses 11-12).

While change is all around us through all of life, it helps me to remember what someone said: "If nothing ever changed, there'd be no butterflies." With that in mind, here is a thought from one of my favorite authors and Christian thinkers, C. S. Lewis:

It may be hard for an egg to turn into a bird: it would be a jolly sight harder for it to learn to fly while remaining an egg. We are like eggs at present. And you cannot go on indefinitely being just an ordinary, decent egg. We must be hatched or go bad. (C. S. Lewis)

God is working in all of us to bring us to completion, to maturity in faith, in Jesus. God's plan for the good people of Millington is now encompassing Pastor Nick, and, by God's grace, Janine and I will find God's purposes for us unfolding in Caro and . . . well, wherever we might travel from a new "base camp."

Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy - to the only wise God our Savior, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen. (Jude 24, 25 - KJV)

We have received an update from the Walugembes. Due to the Covid-19 situation they are stranded in Mackinaw City. The Ugandan government are refusing to allow them to return. However, with the help of technology, they are able to stay in contact and carry out much of their ministry from afar.

I have also been in contact with Steve Lambert, our missionary to the students at CMU, Central Michigan University. The University is closed and thus there is little if any face to face contact with students, but with various means, i.e. phone, smart phone, internet, zoom etc., he and his wife are able to continue their ministry.

They are planning on more face to face contact by fall, God willing.

All of these people are still free from the virus, continue to pray for their safety and their ministry.


Please be aware that as of the print date, none of the bible studies and church services are scheduled to happen. But if there are changes to that, you will have the correct dates and times.

Thanks to all who continue to send in their tithes/offerings to help offset the church expenses. We appreciate your faithfulness to God and your Church.




